Young Leisure Scholar Award

To encourage scholarship in the area of Leisure Studies and to attract and encourage young scholars to significantly contribute to leisure studies, a **Young Leisure Scholar Award** has been instituted on behalf of ISA RC 13. The award will be given to a young scholar who contributes the best paper on the occasion of RC 13 Conferences both mid-term as well as ISA World Congresses. In case there is more than one mid-term conference the award will be given on all these occasions.

A cash prize of US \$ 100 and a citation will be given to the selected scholar.

The terms and conditions for selection of the Award are as follows:

- 1 The age of the scholar at the time of paper presentation should not be more than 40 years.
- 2 S/he should be a member of RC 13 at the time of contributing the paper.
- 3 Full and final paper must be submitted at least 60 days before the conference in hard copy as well as soft copy on CD to both the President and the Secretary of RC 13.
- 4 Papers by joint authors will not be considered for the award.
- 5 The excellence of the paper will be adjudged by an independent committee of five members, The paper must conform to the format and length prescribed as under:
 - a. The length of paper should be between 5000 – 6000 words.
 - b. Referencing system should be the same as used in the ISA Journals.
 - c. The name, identity and email address of the contributor be mentioned on a separate sheet of paper.
- 6 The award will be presented on the occasion of the conference itself.
